

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

June 8, 2016

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Todd Hawkes at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Mayor Todd Hawkes, Council members – John Packer, Emily Chatterton, Joyce Bayles, and Bryce Wood.

Also present: Ashley Archibald, Nicholas Bassett, Jana Morrison, Justin Morrison, and Becky Cox.

Minutes from the May 11, 2016 council meeting were approved. Emily Chatterton made the motion to accept the minutes as written. John Packer seconded. Unanimous.

The May bills were reviewed. ___ made the motion to pay the bills. ___ seconded. Unanimous.

Business:

Bassett's Kennel License and Vicious Dog Registration

Action needed by the Bassett's – they have 3 dogs so a kennel license is needed, and one vicious dog. Ashley Archibald said the kennel has been built to city standards and are waiting for approval on it. Mayor Hawkes said that Corey Richards needs to check it out to approve it.

Justin Morrison – Eagle Scout Project

Justin Morrison presented his Eagle Scout project to the council. He proposes to build a solar panel on Little Mountain to provide energy for the lights on the 1860. It would have a remote control turn on/off. He estimates the cost to be \$3,200.00. John Packer asked how much the panel and battery cost separately and said that he knows of someone who might donate the panel. Mayor Hawkes suggested that Justin also talk to Wayne Priestley to see about monetary help from the Lion's Club, and to ask where they are with their plans to run a power line up to the 1860. John Packer offered to talk to Wayne Priestley and also to Richard Shipley about donating a solar panel. Jana Morrison said they are also going to ask for a donation from Justin's dad's work. Mayor Hawkes asked about the time frame for the project and they want to have it

finished by July 24th. The city will donate \$50 towards the project and John Packer said he also would personally donate.

EPS's targeted air shed grant – Request for letter of support

Mayor Hawkes said he needs more information on this to know if we want to support it or not. He said maybe we can set up a meeting where Melissa Gibbs from DEQ comes down to talk about it. Mayor Hawkes advised the council to read and study it before they give him an idea of what they want him to do.

Bryce wood made the motion to move into Executive Session at 7:25 pm. ___ seconded. Unanimous.

John Packer asked about the bidding on the sewer project. Mayor Hawkes said that he and Jeremy Kimpton had met with funding agencies today. JUB gave out bid packets with all the information. Bids will be opened in a regular city council meeting.
