Meeting was called to order by Mayor Todd Hawkes at 7:00 pm.

Present: Mayor Todd Hawkes, Council: Joyce Bayles, John Packer and Bryce Wood.

Emily Chatterton was absent.

Also Present: Jeremy Naef, Becky Cox from Preston Citizen, Dennis P. Carlson, Kirby Chatterton, and Rusty Chatterton. Mark Dietrich did not sign in.

Mayor Hawkes welcomed everyone to this meeting.

The minutes from regular city council meeting held on August 10, 2016 and Special City Council Meeting held on August 31, 2016 and minutes from Public Hearing for the Dog Fine Increase and Public Hearing for the FY2017 Budget were read. Bryce Wood made the motion to accept the minutes as written. John Packer seconded. Unanimous.

The August bills were reviewed. Joyce Bayles made the motion to pay the bills. Bryce Wood seconded. Unanimous.

Bryce Wood made the motion to have SICOG pay the bills for JUB Engineers for \$89,384, Whitaker Construction Company for \$165,110 and SICOG bill for \$9,000 all for the Wastewater Project. Joyce Bayles seconded. Unanimous.

Business License for Cowboy's Auto Body and Customizing – Jeremy Naef: Mayor Hawkes asked Jeremy Naef to explain his business to the council. Jeremy stated that he is doing what his dad did before he died and he loves doing this type of work of working on cars and customizing cars and he wants to hand this down to his sons. Jeremy Naef stated that he will only be working on one car at a time so there will not be cars all over the place. Bryce Wood asked about his clientele. Jeremy stated that he has people waiting for him to start. John Packer expressed some concerns but he went and visited with Jeremy at his location and he got all his questions answered. John Packer also stated that there is a 6 foot fence that could hold more cars behind it. Dennis Carlson stated that Jeremy Naef does really nice work and he is very talented and smart. Mark Dietrich asked how many cars he will be having around

his place. Jeremy stated that he will only work on one car at a time and he can fit up to four cars in his shop at a time.

Bryce Wood made the motion to grant Cowboy's Auto Body and Customizing a business license. Joyce Bayles seconded. Unanimous.

Resolution 2016-9-14 - \$1.00 increase in water rates: Mayor Hawkes stated that this was discussed in a public hearing last month about this rate increase. Joyce Bayles stated that she appreciated the citizens coming and the comments that was said. There were no other discussion.




